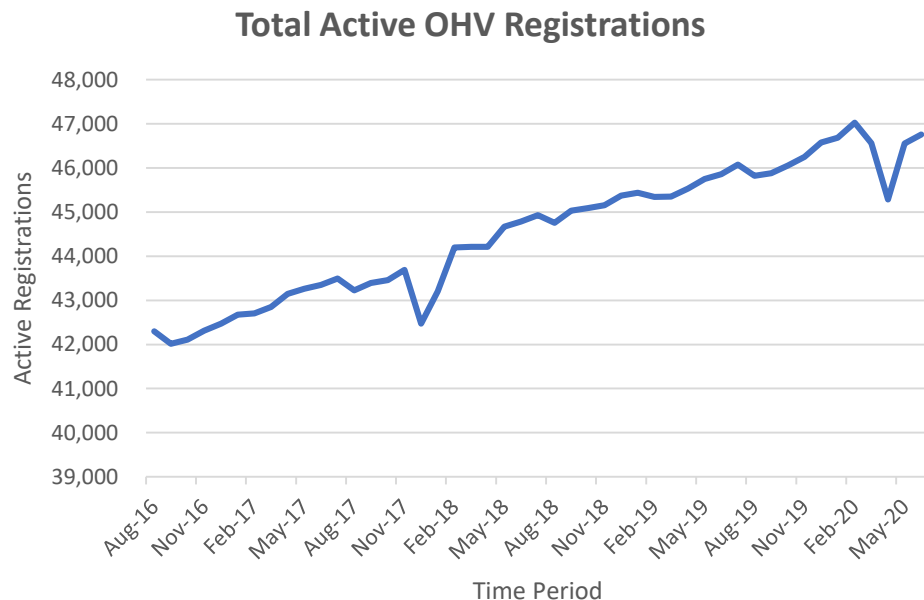

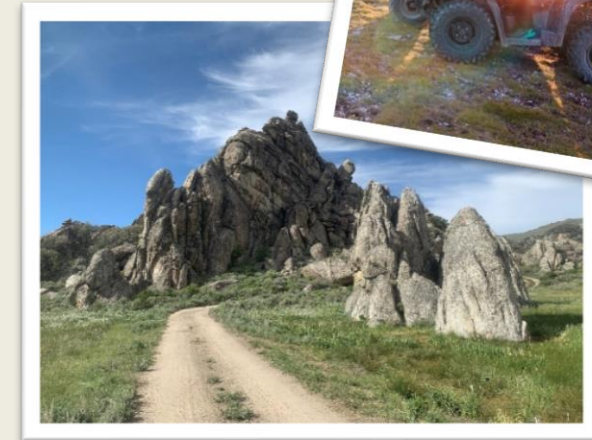
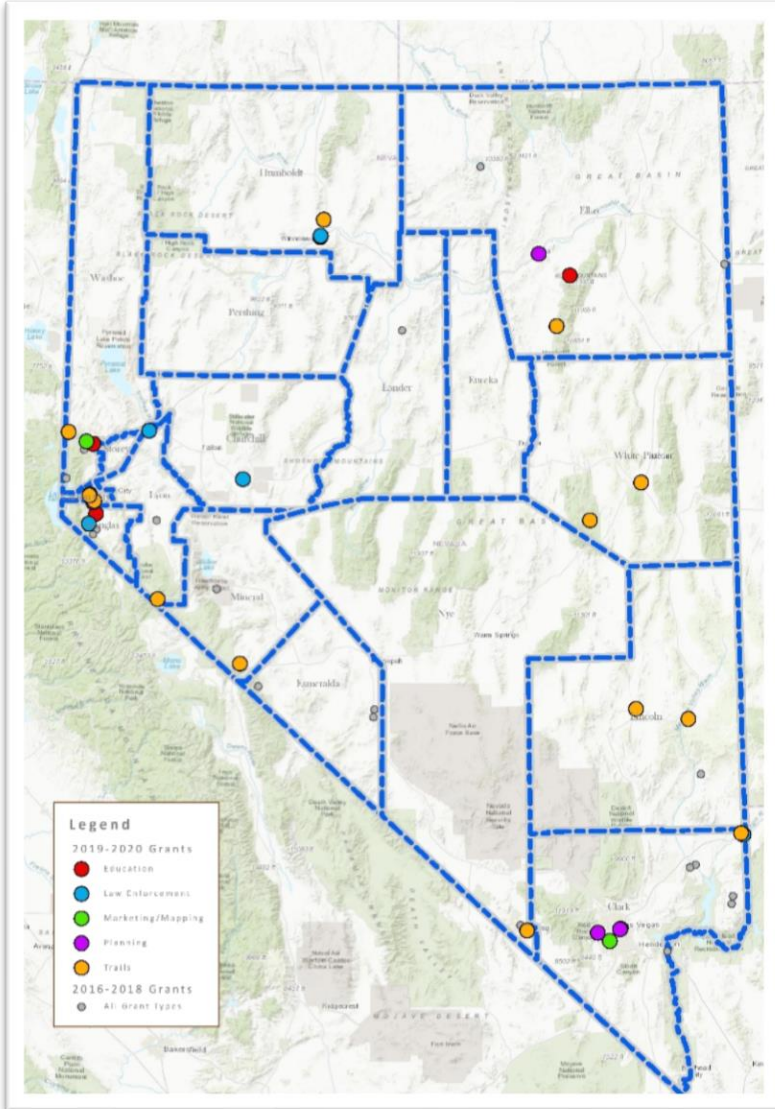

- No Draft Language

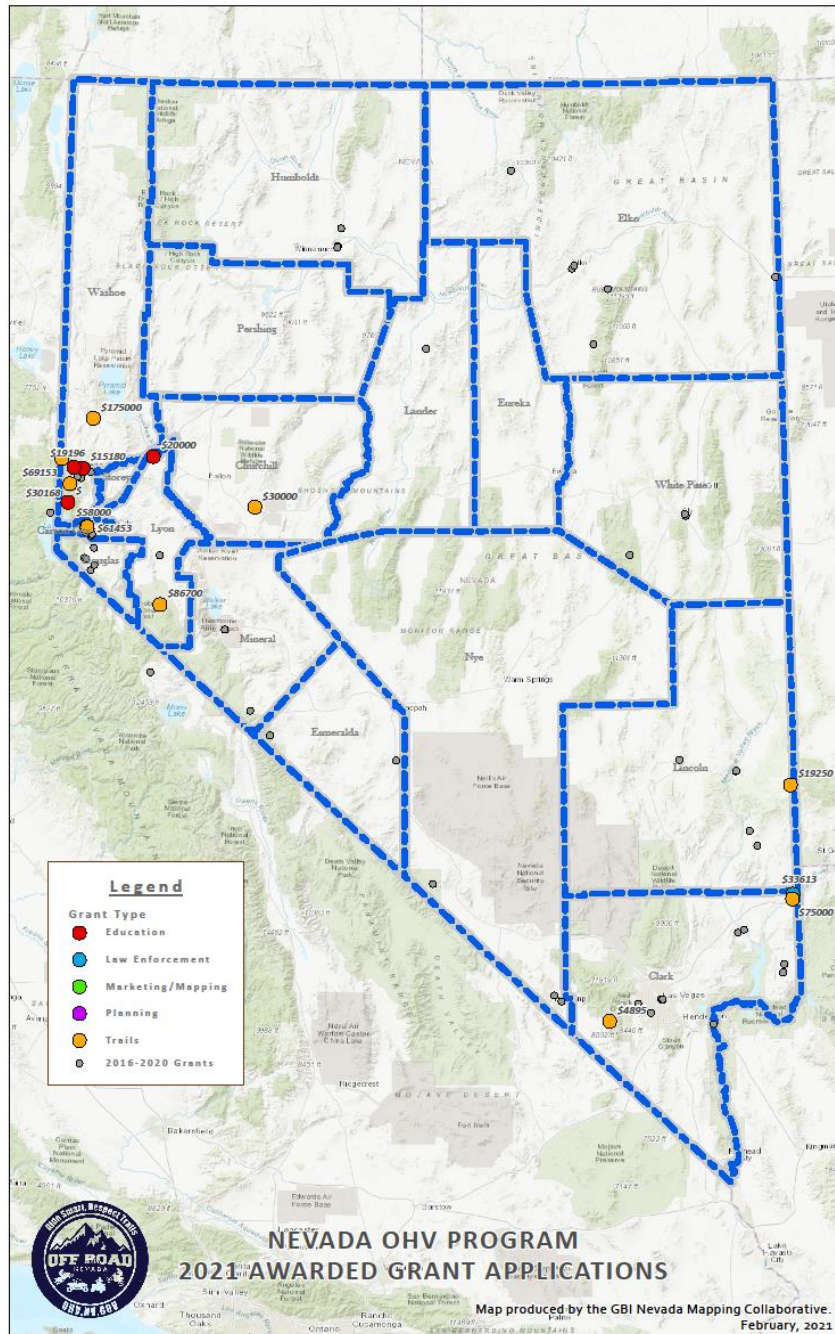
