Nevada Mapping Collaborative Project Status

- MAPPING

- Over 16,500 Miles of Trail have been added to the statewide database
- Data includes 69 of 89 Identified Unique Trail Systems
- Primary new trail systems recently completed and ready for posting to the website:
 - Gold Butte National Monument & Back Country Trail
 - Rainbow Gardens
 - Southern Lincoln County – Mesquite to Caliente

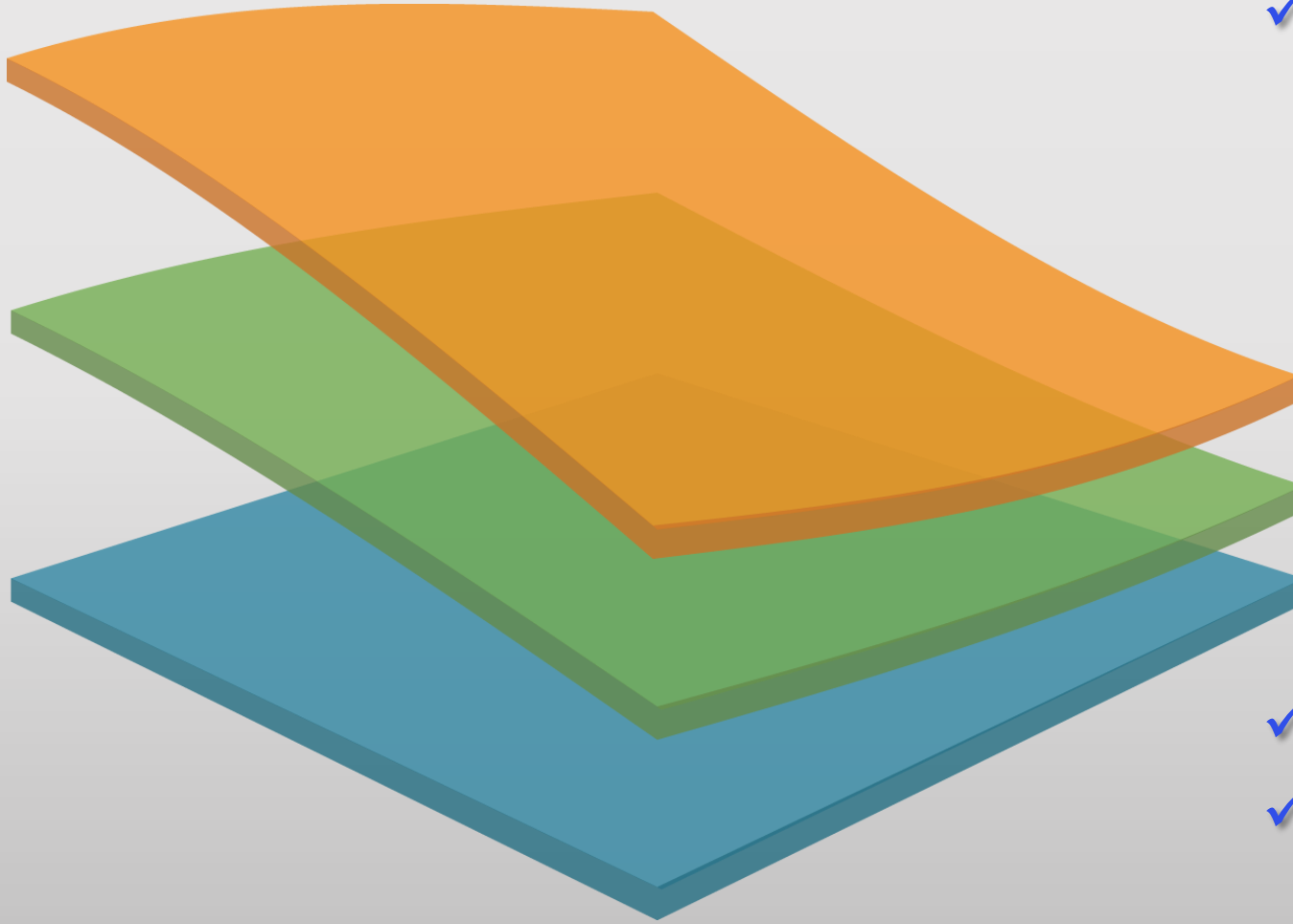
- FIELD DATA COLLECTION

- GBI Field Crew completed data collection tours in Lincoln, Clark, Nye, Esmeralda, Mineral, Lyon, Douglas, Carson and Washoe Counties since January 1.
- Field work focused on Southern Nevada and local tours during winter months, with 1,600+ miles of GPS data collected.

- WEBSITE UPGRADES

- Addition of “Get The Dirt” pages, with 19 trail systems complete to date
- All website data now available for download

Multi-layered Trail Mapping Process



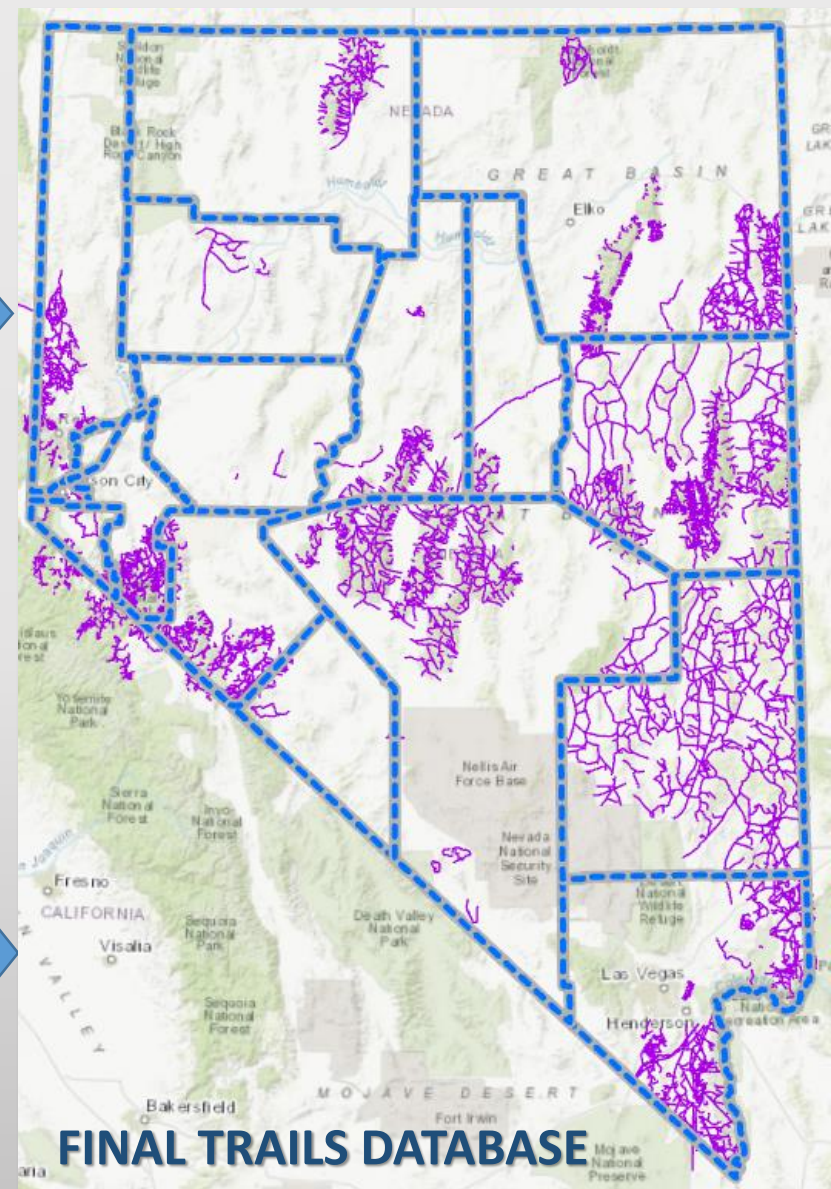
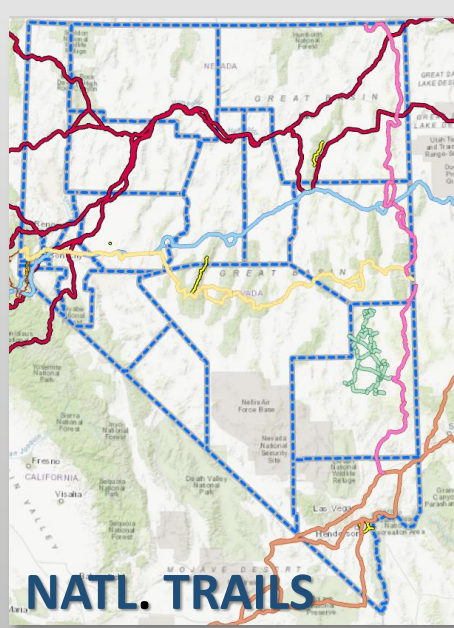
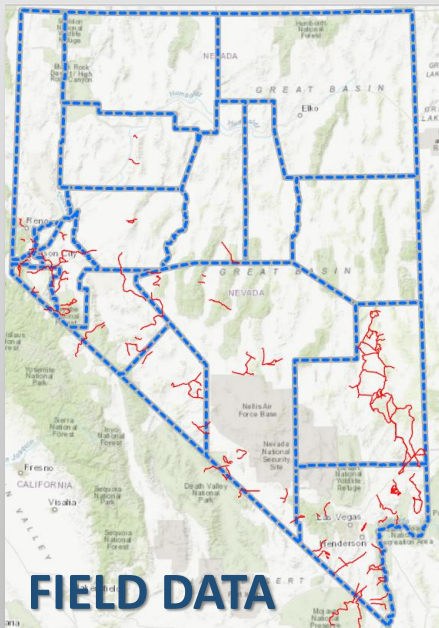
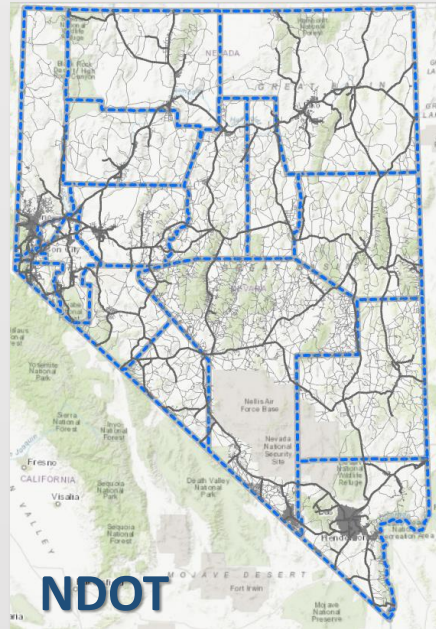
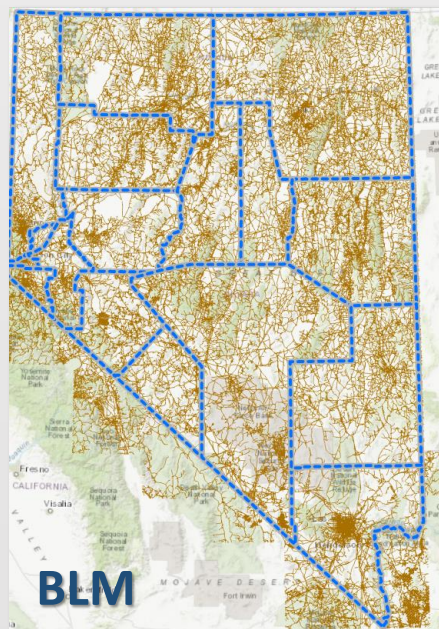
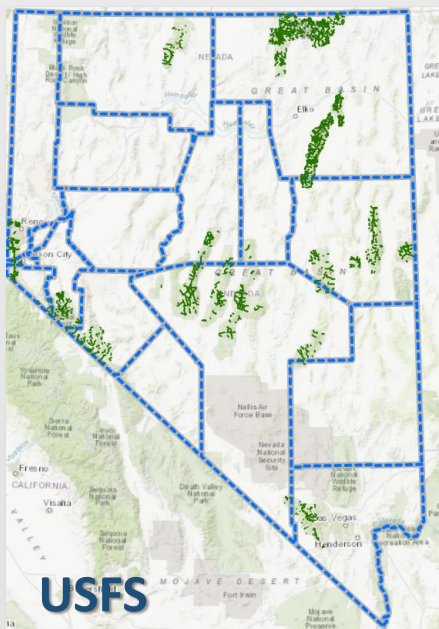
