



KEY REGULATIONS

An off-highway vehicle (OHV) is defined as a motor vehicle designed primarily for off-highway and all torrain use. The term includes, but is not limited to: all terrain vehicle LATV), off-nighway motorcycle (OHM), dune buggy, snuwmobile, ut lifty vehicle (UTV) also known as side-by-side, or any other vehicle used on public lands for recreation

NRS 483,580 states that parents can be held for negligence for allowing any unlicensed minor less than eighteen (18) years of age to drive a vehicle upon any public maintained road or highway. All OHV drivers must be licensed or if under sixteen (16) years of age they must be accompanied by an adult, idensed driver at least actumps need by an adult, represent men at least alighteen years old. Any minor under sixteen must be under visual supervision when operating on a county or city maintained road.

To register your OHV click on the REGISTRATION TAB on the header.

Nevada's program to register and title off-highway vehicles (OHVs) went into effect July 1, 2012. Nearly all OHVs greater than 70cc, and 1976 or newer, must be registered and display a registration decal to be operated legally in the Silver State.

The cost for an annual registration is \$21. Applications are accepted and decals are issued by mail only. See Registration and Frequently Asked Questions for complete details.

Additionally, OHV dealers must be specifically licensed to sell off-highway vehicles.




Trails – USFS, BLM, Clark County & Nevada State Parks








