

## MISSION STATEMENT

**The Nevada Off- Highway Vehicle Commissions Mission is to “Promote Responsible Off-Highway Vehicle Recreation in Nevada.” The Commission distributes money collected from the sale of the registration decals to enhance motorized off- highway vehicle riding opportunities and enjoyment within Nevada. It will also affect laws pertaining to and governing the use of Off Highway Motorized Recreational Vehicles in Nevada.**

### **Where the money goes: Benefits of the OHV Program**

The Nevada OHV Registration Program fees fund trail maintenance, trail construction, rehabilitation, trailheads, parking areas, trail signs, maps, studies to maintain or create new riding areas, public education/outreach, law enforcement and land acquisition. Law enforcement personnel can enforce responsible OHV usage that promotes respect for public and private lands. The Commission can be a strong advocate for OHV recreation in the State.

### **Many groups benefit from OHV registration, including:**

- OHV owners and operators;
- Towns and counties that want to attract OHV recreationist to enhance their local economies; and
- The general public; educated OHV enthusiasts are more conscientious and better stewards of the land.

Registration funds also enable local, state and federal land managers to better manage our natural resources. The Commission can leverage or augment their funding sources for larger OHV projects in the state. If all Nevada OHV owners register their vehicles this can fund up to \$4 million in benefits per year.
