Total Grants Awarded: \$1,042,922


Trail Projects: 7

Q1 2020

January – March – Last update 5/13

1. 2020 OHV Grant agreements

- Draft project specific language and budget based on award.
- Obtain signatures from all parties
- Ensure recipient can receive funds from the OHV account
- Challenge: Cottonwood OHV Trail Agreement

2. Presentation to Humboldt County Commission

- Sand Dunes, NOS, HCSO Safety and Enforcement
- Sand dunes will progress as awarded

3. Legislative Committee on Public Lands

- Answer questions about challenges to the OHV registration process
- Showed positive grant projects around the state
- Planted a seed towards an annual sticker program
