NRS 490.067 (9)

- Per diem and travel expenses for Commission events
- \$ 80 / day stipend for Commission Events (State employees & officers exempt)
- Work to create and promote responsible off-highway vehicle recreation in the State
- Must not miss 3 consecutive meetings

NRS 490.068

- Elect Chair & Vice Chair
- Meetings four times annually
- Provide direction to OHV Program
- Award OHV Grants



How are Grant Funds Used?

(NRS 490.069)

Pertaining to OHV trails and facilities:

1. Studies or Planning
 2. Mapping and Signage
 3. Land Acquisition
 4. Enhancement or Maintenance
 5. Construction
 6. Restoration of Damage Areas
 7. Features to Minimize Environmental Impacts
- AND
8. OHV Safety Training and Education
 9. Improve OHV Registration and Enforcement




