Humboldt County Sheriff's Officers will be able to do safety training and OHV registration at the Winnemucca Sand Dunes, also the sheriff's Search and Rescue unit will be able to hold trainings with the installation of a vault toilet and tables. Nevada Outdoor School will be able to hold their ATV/OHV rider camps and safety trainings in this area with a public restroom and tables for the trainees to use.

2. Trail mapping, signing and maintenance of existing trails and facilities: Please describe how your project/program assists in the maintenance and/or rehabilitation of Existing Facilities. "Taking care of what is already there to protect the investment."

All new construction for environmental and public safety. At this time, there are no facilities at this high use recreation area.

3. Training: Please describe the goals and objectives of your public training program, i.e., Public Education, Rider Classes, Safety, Trail Building, or Outdoor Ethics. Number of people trained, contacts made, etc.

Nevada Outdoor School (NOS)'s Outdoor Ethics program provides targeted OHV registration, education and outreach to thousands of people in Nevada. With public restrooms and tables in this area they will be able to put on their rider camps and safety courses in this area. Nevada Outdoor School will be co-hosting OHV registration and VIN inspection drives with our local Sheriff's department and that can be held at the Winnemucca Sand Dunes with public restrooms and tables to work off from.

- 4. Law Enforcement, SAR with NO Registration component: How will your officer training, equipment purchase or salary/overtime request serve the off-highway vehicle recreating public? N/A
- 5. Access: Please describe how your project/program ensures protection of access. Explain what access/opportunities would be lost or restricted if the project doesn't occur.

At this time, there is no signage or instructions for entry at this high use off road recreation area. We propose to install signage to mark the area on US 95, it would be very beneficial to the traveling public to inform them of this recreational area since there are none presently. An informational kiosk and restrooms will encourage public passersby to stop and enjoy this area.

If the recreation area is improved with toilets and tables, more people from outside the community visiting the area will be stopping in Winnemucca to purchase food, gas and possibly motel rooms to ride the sand dunes. This area is also used extensively by the local community and the Winnemucca BLM District Office, Humboldt County Commissioners and the Humboldt County Sheriff's Office is in full support of this project.

NNATV will utilize trail systems and much loved recreation areas such as Buckskin Table Mountain Loop and Lye Creek Campground in the Santa Rosa Mountains, Shoshone ATV Trails, Sand Mountain Recreation Area, the Winnemucca Sand Dunes, The Black Rock Desert High-Rock Canyon Emigrant Trails National Conservation Area, Water Canyon and many other sites to provide educational outreach to the public. This outreach will focus on outdoor ethics and ATV/OHV and dirt bike safety, especially among youth. Utilizing the surrounding existing trails and recreation areas will promote a vested interest in these and other public lands to keep them clean and safe for generations to come.

8. Planning, Environmental Studies, Conservation: please describe how the environmental studies and/or planning will result in maintaining or expanding OHV riding areas. Describe HOW your project/program considers water and habitat conservation.

The Winnemucca Sand Dunes is a high use off road recreation area. Installing a vault toilet will help clean up the area for environmental reasons and public safety due to people just leaving behind human waste and garbage. This will also preserve the habitat for the animals that live there.

9. This project is in partnership with the Winnemucca BLM District Office, the Humboldt County Sheriff's Office, the Humboldt County Commission, Nevada Outdoor School and our own ATV Club. Federal match will come from BLM for their hours spent on the project. In-kind match will come from the ATV Club and other community volunteers. NDOT has verbally agreed to upgrade the cattle guard if this grant is approved Letters of support are included with this grant application.

Again, this is a high use off road recreation area and at this time there are no facilities or picnic tables there. People leave garbage and human waste behind which negatively affects the environment. Tables will be beneficial to off road users as well as public passersby who will potentially stop to enjoy a picnic and the outdoor area. An informational kiosk will inform users of the partners involved and the funding source for the improvement project.

Maintenance: Although this OHV grant program requires maintenance of all facilities funded for 25 years or the normal life of the project, please describe HOW your project will be maintained and WHO has committed to the ongoing maintenance of the facility or continuation of the service/program. Winnemucca District BLM will be the ones responsible for maintaining this facility after it is installed along with volunteers from NNATV and other community groups.




