Once our signage is in place, we will be able to educate the youth on safety. The White Pine County Sheriff's Department has given its stamp of approval on installing signage at Ely's ingress/egress OHV routes.

2. Trail mapping, signing and maintenance of existing trails and facilities: Please describe how your project/program assists in the maintenance and/or rehabilitation of Existing Facilities. "Taking care of what is already there to protect the investment."

Prior to July 2018, the City of Ely did not have designated OHV routes. In collaboration with the local High Desert Trail Blazers OHV club, the White Pine County Sheriff's Department, the Bureau of Land Management (BLM), the U.S. Forest Service (USFS) and White Pine County, a map of OHV routes was approved by the Ely City Council. Now since the OHV routes have been approved, the next step will be signage. The beauty of the City's OHV route now is that tourists from local hotels can access our wonderful trails throughout the area, as can our locals. Once signage is in place online access maps and kiosks will be available to the public. We will finally be an OHV friendly community.

Without the OHV designated routes, those people not familiar with the area have no reason to enjoy our trails. The City's Road Department is underfunded and this grant for signage will help facilitate the use of Ely's OHV access routes.

Once OHV signage is in place, website links will further disseminate the OHV access map information, as well as kiosks throughout the community.

The City's OHV routes will connect to the County trails and ultimately to BLM and USFS trails.

Designated routes will keep riders controlled by a posted lower speed limit of 15 MPH and keep off road vehicles from heavily-traveled City streets.

Due to the fact that the City's Road Department is extremely underfunded, a severe snowfall could wipe out its budget. The City will use our Road crew to the fullest to initiate the Ely OHV Access Route Signage Project and the High Desert Trail Blazers OHV club has volunteered their members to help implement the grant.

10. Demand for New Facilities: Please provide justification (the demand) for NEW facility/program development: restrooms, trails, signs, and other amenities.

As the City had no OHV routes within the City or "mapping of trails", the need for some kind of routing was indicated through complaints from outdoors enthusiasts and local businesses. The OHV access route maps will allow tourists to access trails just outside of City parameters. In 2017, the City engaged in meetings with outdoor enthusiasts, the White Pine County Sheriff's Office, BLM, USFS and the local High Desert Trail Blazers OHV club to hammer out OHV access route details.



Our club recommends approval of Ely's grant to help make and keep Ely and Nevada OHV friendly.


