



## Nevada's Off-Highway Vehicles Program 2020 Grant Round Opening September 12 – November 12, 2019



The Nevada Off-Highway Vehicles Program promotes safe and responsible use of Nevada's outstanding opportunities for off-road recreation by providing grants from Nevada's OHV registration fee proceeds.

Approximately \$900,000 in funding is available for the 2020-2021 fiscal years.

The Nevada Off-Highway Vehicle Program is administered through the Nevada Department of Conservation and Natural Resources.

The program provides grants to fund off-highway vehicle related projects throughout the state including trail improvements, mapping, signage, law enforcement, education, safety training, and restoration.

### **Eligible projects include but are not limited to:**

- Trail maps and signage.
- Construction or maintenance of trails.
- Trailheads, trailside facilities.
- Safety and education programs.
- Registration enforcement.
- Registration awareness initiatives, events.
- Restoration of areas where OHVs have caused damage.
- Environmental studies, cultural and historical surveys and NEPA.
- Motorized trail use management operations including snow grooming.
- Trail building equipment and tools.
- Easements or purchase of lands from willing seller for the explicit purpose of securing motorized trail corridors or access.
