User interaction will be managed thru conducting ROHVA certified rider safety and trail riding classes, distributing information regarding Licensing and registration of OHV and field contacts with users.

Type here: The Sheriff's Office will provide certified ROHVA safety and trail riding classes with certified instructors, educate users by distributing licensing and registration requirements for ATV/UTV vehicles and enforcement of the current laws.

We will also use the equipment to extricate lost or injured people in the remote areas of our county. These efforts encompass approximately 5000 square miles with a majority of OHV activity in the Eastern portion of the county. We have high use areas such as the Sand Mountain Recreation area, The Fairview area, The Alpine range area and the Stillwater mountain range area. We also have some medium use areas such as the 40 mile desert area, the Pony Express trail areas and the Edwards Creek areas.

We will conduct a minimum of two Safety/riding classes a year conducted by certified instructors and the classes are 8 hours in length consisting of classroom, obstacle courses and trail rides. We also conduct VIN inspections on participants units at the time of the class and explain and distribute the OHV licensing and registration process. We will conduct a minimum of two VIN number inspections at the Fairgrounds where we will again hand out the literature about proper licensing and registration of ATV/UTV units. We do this at no cost to the participants. We do enforcement of OHV violations within Churchill County concentrating on the areas mentioned.

We received an OHV vehicle, equipment and trailer from a 2019 grant and have used it extensively and accomplished what we said we would do. It's use has become more essential as OHV use has steadily increased. We are proposing a second vehicle to increase our ability to cover the areas as at times we have more than one call for service for injured people in different locations in rough terrain. This would give us the opportunity to patrol more than

one area or double our patrols during holiday weekends or other heavy use times.

We are proposing to purchase another unit, a trailer to transport and store the unit within the fenced area at the Sheriff's Office. The unit would be capable of carrying a minimum of two people plus a patient on a gurney along with a medical person.

SPECIFIC OBJECTIVES, GOAL AND TIMELINE:

- (1) The Sheriff's Office will purchase an OHV side by side capable of carrying two people, a patient on a gurney and a medical attendant. This will include a radio/siren, emergency lights, and Sheriff markings, an enclosed trailer to haul and store the unit.
- (2) Purchase a gurney assembly to allow the patient to be carried on a backboard.
- (3) Conduct a least two safety classes with VIN/registration checks each year.
- (4) Conduct patrols throughout the county in the before mentions areas along with several Off-road races held in our area. Double our patrol on high use weekends and holidays.
- (5) Document contacts with users throughout the use using the Spillman system.
- (6) Take enforcement action as needed with users.
- (7) Furnish quarterly progress reports to the OHV commission including:
 - Number of contacts regarding OHV licensing and registration or other incidents and accidents.
 - b) Number of contacts resulting in citation or other enforcement action.
 - c) Number of VIN inspections
 - d) Number of hours and mileage equipment was utilized.
 - e) Number of man hours worked on OHV activities
