Elko Motocross Club seeks to purchase the materials needed to install a waterline from the City of Elko main water system to the motocross track location. This will be done through a proposed inter-local agreement between Elko County and the City of Elko. Elko County has allocated five water shares to this facility and the City of Elko has offered to provide water to the Elko Motocross Track in exchange for these five water shares. These shares will be moved to a future well to be installed just south of our location. In the proposed agreement, the City of Elko will install the water line from its current location at Komatsu Equipment across City/County line up towards our track. The distance of line the city will install once it reaches our leased parcel is still pending. This grant request includes funds to cover 300' of the total 750' of line to install. While this agreement is in the process of being finalized, the rental of an excavator for water line installation and additional track side watering supplies will still be needed to continue the installation of lines and water draw points throughout the track. (It should be noted that the pipe for the track side system was purchased with previous grant funding.) Elko Motocross Club also is seeking funding for other additional expenses. It will be necessary to purchase a medium-sized tractor with

grooming attachment to maintain the start gate stretch along with other flat areas of the track. Bleachers for spectators will be also needed. A pre-built building will be necessary for event registration and to house the equipment to be used for rider tracking equipment (capable of tracking all riders' positions during races). It will also be necessary to install electricity to the facility. A portable light plant will be used to power the registration computers and to provide area lighting around the registration building. It will also be necessary to obtain operating costs and funds to maintain the new and previously purchased equipment. It is hoped to have the power installed and the water line completed in 2023.



SECTION V – PRIORITIES AND SCORING NARRATIVE

Grants will be scored based on answers to the Ten (10) criteria listed below. Each criteria carries a weight determined by the OHV Commission, voted upon during the public meeting on 9/7/2021. Please reference scoring criteria form.

- Law Enforcement Strategy that addresses registration enforcement, including Public Education & Outreach aimed at increasing renewals and new registrations: EMC unanimously voted to amend bylaws requiring ohv registration for 70cc and above for all local members of club. It was also discussed allowing for a discount for riders not in the club who show proof of ohv registration.
- Enhancement or Maintenance of existing trails and facilities: This grant submission is targeted to create a new offroad complex, in Elko County. This will reduce the use of existing less-quality areas, reducing non sanctioned less safe, and more environmentally damaging behaviors.
- Training: The facility will be available for formal training events and could be the location for formal training to SxS or ATV safety classes as well as motocross.
- Trail mapping and signing of existing trails and facilities: N/A
- Connectivity/Loops: N/A
- Planning, Environmental Studies, Conservation: By providing a quality facility, the Elko
 Motocross track will allow for a compact professional grade motocross facility, reducing
 the use of other public land that does not have a management or maintenance plan where
 damage goes unrepaired.
- Access: Access will be to club members and race participants. The facility is also available by request from a recognized group for safety education events, or training.
- Partnering and Leverage: Elko County as the owner of this land and has planned for the use
 to specifically be for motorized recreation. Elko County has leased this parcel to the Elko
 Motocross club, for the specific development of the motocross portion of the land.
- Economic Integration: A Georgia Tech study indicates that the total economic impact of
 motocross on the community is 66 jobs, \$1.7 million in personal income and \$3.8 million in
 economic output annually. Additionally, motocross generates approximately \$263,000 in
 state and local government tax revenues, the report states.
- 10. Demand for New Facilities: Elko as the county seat has the largest population density in Elko County, additionally with is being the first major community west of the 1million plus residents of the Salt Lake Valley, the need for a quality managed and specifically created motocross track is a high priority for the community.
