Esmeralda County Sheriff's Office is responsible for 3,589 sq. miles and 11 mountain ranges within our County. Esmeralda County Sheriff's office is responsible for the enforcement of Nevada Revised Statutes which include NRS 490 Off-Highway Vehicles (OHV) Statute. Esmeraldas County is a prime recreational area for hunting, fishing, hiking and camping. Every town (Goldfield, Silver Peak, Gold Point, Lida and Dyer) in Esmeralda has Holiday Festivities that draw visitors and family, bringing with them their own OHV's. The equipment requested will serve all areas within Esmeralda County. The equipment that we are requesting will aid in the movement of the OHV and the trailer that was bought in 2016 with OHV funds. At this time, we are using personal vehicles to move the trailer/OHV to events around the County. Esmeralda County Sheriff's office puts on three (3) education OHV events per year (Silver Peak, Goldfield and Dyer), we also enforce the OHV Laws on the trails every weekend starting in

		April/May to September/October (depending on weather and other events that take place within the County). This equipment is a vital need to keep enforcing the OHV Laws and making appearances within the County. Esmeralda County understands that the Equipment will not only be used for OHV projects so we are looking at splitting the cost of this project. This project is needed to keep up with the weight of the trailer and the dirt roads that are within the County.
