forecasts that are free to the public, and free OHV-specific avalanche classes. The majority of users are snowmobilers and snowbikers who are residents of the Reno/Carson areas.

If applicable, please explain how this project will aid with managing user interactions:: Avalanche information and education is typically targeted to non-motorized users. This project targets motorized users, so a primary topic in classes will address differences between the user groups, and tips for interacting with non-

motorized users.

5. Scope of Work and Deliverables

Scope of work description:: This project includes free to the public OHV-specific Avalanche Awareness classes, offered indoors in Carson City, Reno, Winnemucca, and Elko. It also includes a free to the public indoor/outdoor Avalanche Rescue class in Elko/Lamoille Canyon. Friends of the Bridgeport Avalanche Center is a recognized provider of the American Avalanche Association, which oversees all avalanche education in the United States. <https://www.americanavalancheassociation.org/education-overview> Over the summer of 2026, Friends of the Bridgeport Avalanche Center will spend time planning the project. This includes coordination with local stakeholders to determine dates for classes, securing venues (at powersports dealerships) for Awareness classes, scheduling instructors, planning logistics, purchasing supplies and print materials, and developing curriculum. Promoting the classes would occur in the fall of 2026. Awareness classes in Carson City and Reno would also occur during this time. The projector and screen (equipment purchase) would be used to present a slideshow and videos at all four Awareness classes and the indoor portion of the Rescue class. During winter of 2027, Friends of the Bridgeport Avalanche Center would offer the Avalanche Awareness classes in Winnemucca and Elko, and the Avalanche Rescue class in Elko/Lamoille Canyon.

Project deliverables description:: Avalanche Awareness classes last approximately an hour, and don't have restrictions on number of attendees. Expected attendance in Carson City and Reno is 10-50 people per event, with a lower maximum attendance in Winnemucca and Elko. Given four total Awareness classes (Carson City, Reno, Winnemucca, and Elko), this project would reach 40 to 150+ people. The Avalanche Rescue class has a brief indoor component that would overlap the Elko-based Awareness class, then be followed by an 8 hour field session. We would limit attendance to 10 people with 2 instructors. A 5:1 ratio is preferred to maximize learning outcomes. 6:1 is the maximum ratio allowed by the American Avalanche Association

6. Commission Priorities

Law Enforcement Strategy:: Promotion of classes will include credit to the NV OHV grant program, funded through NV OHV registrations. Participants in the indoor Awareness classes will be provided with NV registration info. Participants in the field-based Avalanche Rescue class will be required to have current registrations. The primary goal of the project is to increase the safety of winter OHV users by teaching them about avalanches, how to avoid avalanches, and how to rescue victims of avalanches.

Planning, Environmental Studies, and Conservation:: This project is educational. It includes no ground disturbances or permanent installations.

Enhancement or Maintenance of Existing Trails and Facilities:: This project is educational. It includes no ground disturbances or permanent installations.

Training Strategy:: Goals and objectives of Awareness classes are to inform winter OHV users of avalanche basics, including the use of industry accepted PPE and the use of an avalanche specific risk management plan (<https://bridgeportavalanchecenter.org/daily-flow-user-guide/>). Goals and objectives of Avalanche Rescue are to teach winter OHV users how to rescue avalanche victims quickly enough that survival rates are still favorable. All classes offered by this project follow the guidelines of the American Avalanche Association, which oversees avalanche education in the United States. Friends of the Bridgeport Avalanche Center is a recognized provider of the American Avalanche Association. What sets our safety training program apart from the others is that we are OHV users ourselves, and we teach specifically to other OHV users. Most avalanche training in the United States is non-motorized.

Connectivity and Loops:: This project is educational. It includes no ground disturbances or permanent installations.

Access:: Anti-access groups often cite avalanche statistics when attempting to get land managers to close terrain to snowmobilers and snowbikers. Educating snowmobilers and snowbikers about avalanches can reduce accident rates, and also provide users with facts to push back against anti-access groups.

Trail Mapping and Signage:: Mapping is not a component of this project.

Partners and Leverage:: This project will be undertaken by the Friends of the Bridgeport Avalanche center, but because we are partnered with the Humbolt-Toiyabe National Forest they are aware of and support the project. Outreach has also occurred with Elko-based snowmobilers and snowbikers, who requested/inspired many of the project deliverables. It will also involve powersports dealers in Carson City, Reno, Winnemucca, and Elko.

Economic Integration:: Snowmobiling contributes \$30 billion of economic activity in North America (<https://www.snowmobile.org/snowmobile-sales-outperform-economic-growth-worldwide.html>). Considering that Nevada is the most mountainous state, it should be more of a snowmobile destination than it currently is. Because most of the snow covered mountains in Nevada are in rural communities, the economic benefit from increased snowmobile use could be significant. Though it isn't the primary goal of the project, this project will increase awareness of snowmobile opportunities in Nevada.

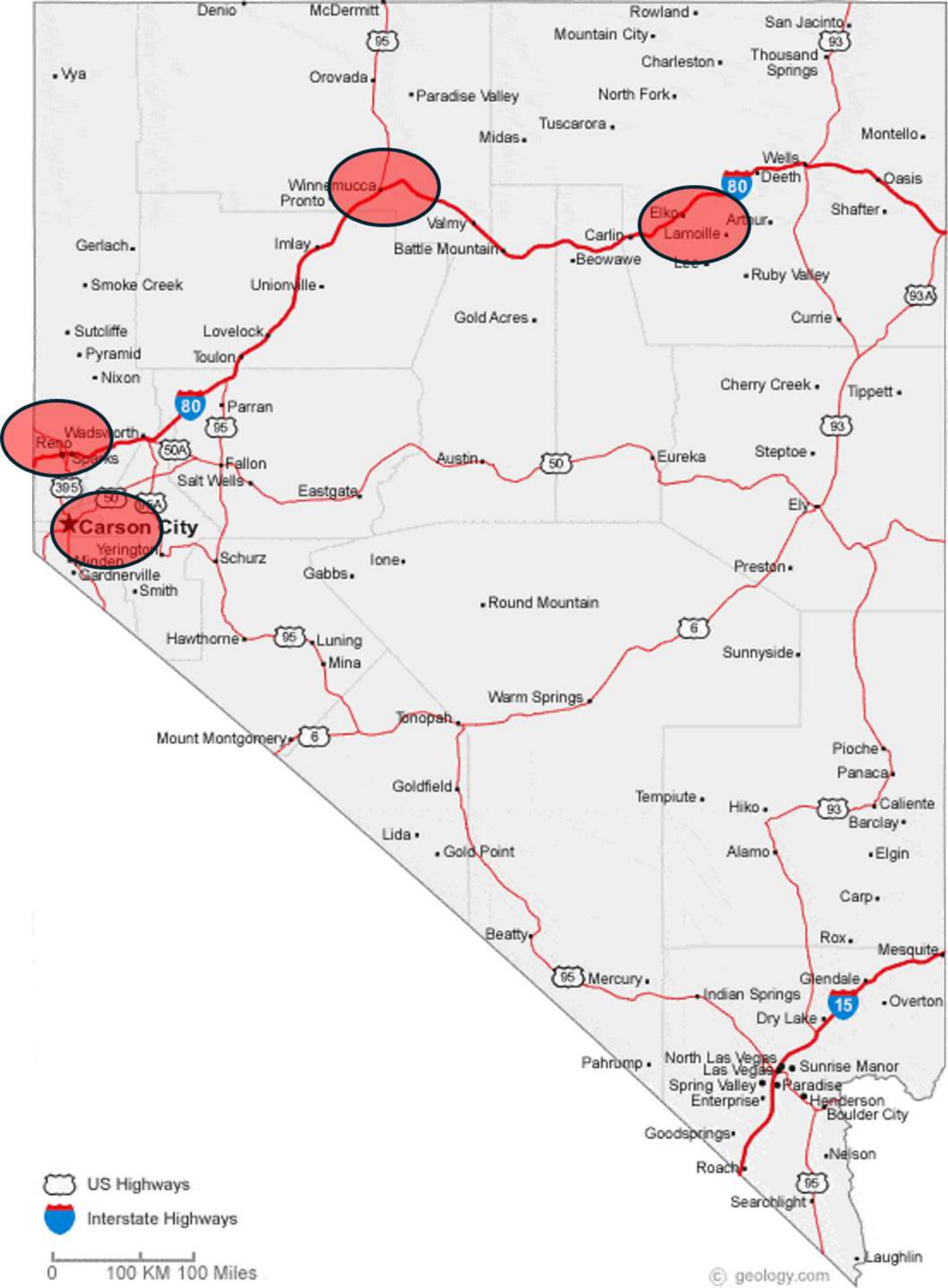

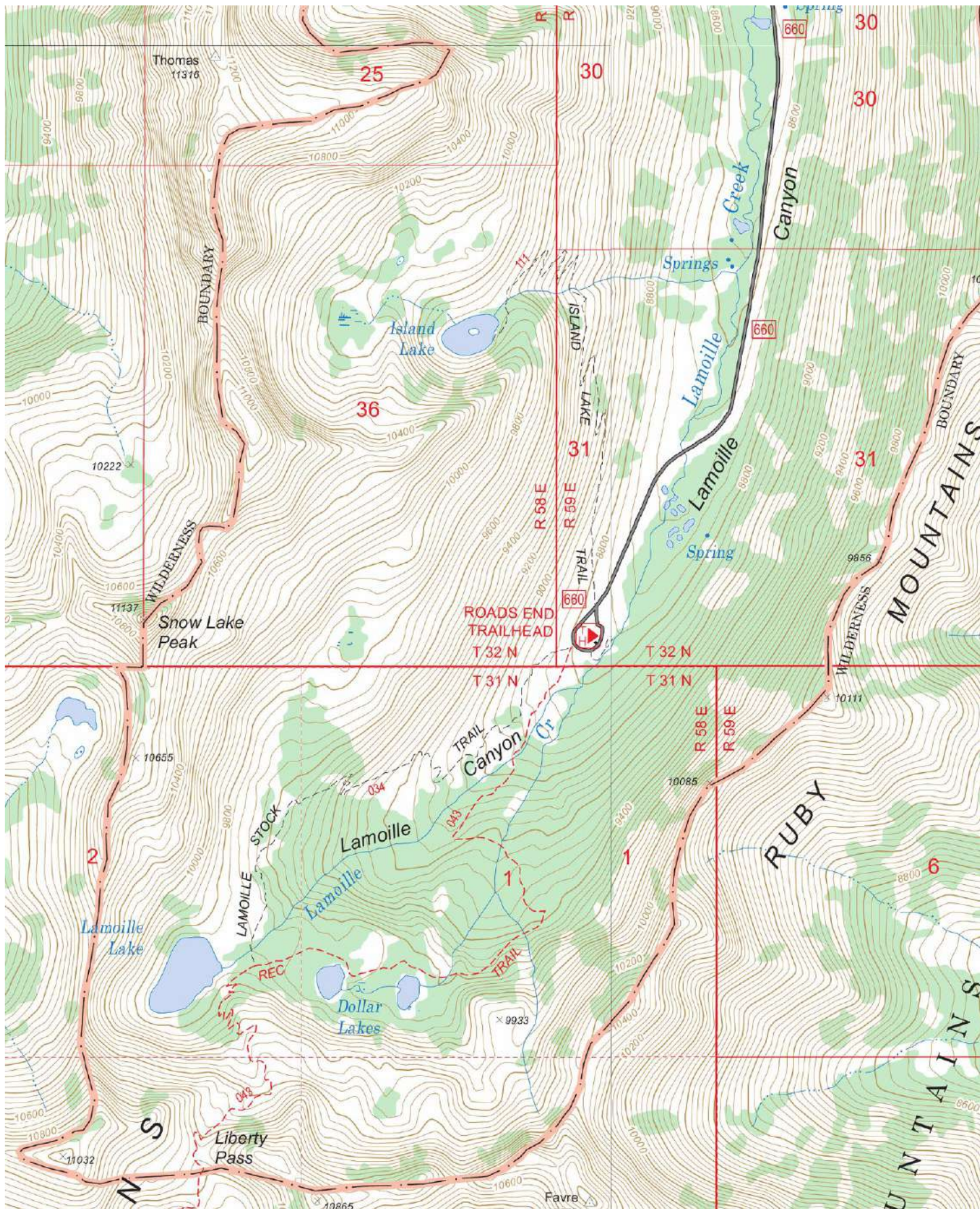
Project Map 1

Planning and Assessments

Planning estimate of 10 hours at a rate of \$41.75, with 20% added for payroll expenses. Match estimate of 10 hours volunteer time at \$32.49 per hour (Independent Sector rate for NV)

Labor

Avalanche Awareness rates of \$300 per event (includes instructor prep) with 20% added for payroll expenses. Same rate applies to match, less payroll expenses, with two events taught by a volunteer.

Avalanche Rescue is paid at \$540 per event (10hr day and instructor prep), with 20% added for payroll expenses. Same rate applies to match, less payroll expenses, for a volunteer instructor

Travel days paid at \$300 per day, with 20% added for payroll expenses. Match estimate of 14 hours at \$32.49 per hour (Independent Sector rate for NV)

Equipment

Projector - Epson Pro EX11000 estimate from internet searches

Screen - 100" portable screen estimate from internet searches

Materials/Supplies

Handouts are educational and would be given to Awareness hosts (powersports dealers) to display/provide to customers after Avalanche Awareness events

Refreshments for attendees to help promote attendance

Snowmobile expenses for instructors to use their personal machines while teaching the Avalanche Rescue class, at a rate of \$150 per day. This covers fuel and other wear items. The alternative would be to rent snowmobiles, which costs \$500/day and adds logistical complexity.

Travel

Lodging, 1 person 3 nights and 1 person 2 nights at \$110/night

Meals, 1 person 4 days and 1 person 3 days at \$68/day

Mileage, 2 vehicles 360 miles each at \$0.725/mile
