\$1 Million in grant funding now available for Off-Highway Vehicle projects throughout Nevada!

Applications due November 16, 2020

The Nevada Off-Highway Vehicles Program promotes safe and responsible use of Nevada's world-class opportunities for off-road recreation by providing grants from Nevada's OHV registration fee proceeds.

The program provides grants to fund Nevada-wide projects including trail improvements, mapping, signage, law enforcement, education, safety training, and restoration. About \$1 million in grant funding is available for projects commencing Jan. 2021 - Dec. 2022.

Examples of eligible projects

- Trail maps and signage
- Environmental studies, cultural and historical surveys and NEPA
- Trail construction or maintenance
- Trailheads, trailside facilities
- Safety and education programs
- Registration enforcement
- Registration awareness initiatives, and events

- Restoration of areas where OHVs
 have caused damage
- Motorized trail use management operations including snow grooming
- Trail building equipment and tools
- Easements or purchase of lands from willing seller for the explicit purpose of securing motorized trail corridors or access
