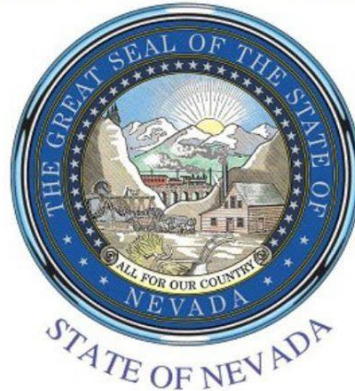

The main purpose of this grant is to promote OHV registration. OHV registration is what funds this program and Whatever M/C believes that by promotion at our event along with the ease of registering their OHV we will see great success from this project and help fund the future through OHV registrations.

This project's focus is obtaining new OHV registrations and promoting a Ride safe Ride smart program, Whatever M/C is a motorcycle club that is a part of MRANN (Motorcycle Racing Association OF Northern Nevada) an organization of over 500 members that will host 9 races in the 2024 season (2 hosted by Whatever M/C). As we know competition events don't require registration and it is not so common to find a registered OHV at a MRANN event. Whatever M/C is ready to change that and assist OHV owners in the entire registration process including the cost of registration and vin inspection. This project would allow Whatever M/C to offer an OHV registration event at a MRANN race located in a heavily OHV concentrated area.

Whatever's first hosting race of the year will be in cold springs just 15 mins north of Reno (on Peter Lissners property, see attached letter below) and is planned to be a very large event.

Whatever M/C's main focus of this race will be OHV registrations Offering free MRANN cards and 120 free OHV registrations. We will be on site to register OHV's all weekend long to meet and exceed our goal of 300 registrations. This mass registration event is open to ALL OHV users that want to participate including non MRANN members. Whatever M/C will seek TV, Paper and social media news outreach for this event to ensure a high public attendance and meet the goals set forth in this grant. Should we not meet our goal of 300 registrations Whatever M/C will continue our registration efforts at our following race and also host a registration event at our projects partners OHV dealership Big Valley Honda. We believe that Whatever M/C can open the long closed door to making OHV registration a part of racing in Northern Nevada through education of the program and ease of obtaining a sticker. We hope to build a long lasting relationship with the OHV commission being stewards of the program and welcoming others to become a part of this great program.

This project's main focus is registration promotion however, Whatever M/C believes that the OHV program is a huge benefit to all Nevadans. It funds projects of all spectrums to protect and better our trails as a whole so, promoting registrations in turn gives more opportunities for improvement across the entire spectrum of the program. It also offers a beginning of a more collaborative relationship between riders and enforcement.

This grant is not based so much around training but education. We have experienced that the motorcycle racing community has not been “as aware as they could be” about the benefits of the OHV commission and its registration/grant program. Whatever M/C intends to educate racers and the community about the program and offer registration free of cost to OHV users. We know that once educated and registered that users will continue to participate in the program.

8. **Law Enforcement Strategy that addresses registration enforcement, including Public Education & Outreach aimed at increasing renewals and new registrations:** *How will your project increase the number of OHV registrations on the district. The project is centered around this goal, Increasing OHV registration. Whatever M/C has taken notice of the lack of OHV registrations at off road racing events and wants to put forth an effort to change this. Whatever M/C will be hosting 2 MRANN race events this year, one of which is located in Cold Springs just 15 minutes from downtown Reno (on Peter Lissners land see letter below). Whatever M/C will have vin inspection staff provided by Big Valley Honda on site to perform vin inspections and staff to assist in the completion of the owner's required paperwork to provide a “mass registration” event at our race for OHV users. Whatever M/C will cover the cost of 120 registrations with a goal of 300 total. We predict that we can easily meet this goal with MRANN members and local support from the community. Whatever M/C will also be contacting media outlets for coverage on the event to further promote the event and registrations. Should the goal not be met at this event, a total of 300 registrations will be fulfilled by December of 2024 via other races and an outreach event at Big Valley Honda if needed.

Whatever M/C has been blessed with a relationship with Lifestyle Homes, A Reno based home builder who owns vast parcels of land across the Reno area. Peter the owner is an OHV user himself and supports the respectful use of his land to support the OHV community in the surrounding areas. Whatever M/C has previously held races at this location with great success including the involvement of the surrounding community in Cold Springs.

Big Valley Honda a local OHV dealer has partnered with Whatever M/C in offering the required vin # inspection form completed free of charge on site at the event. This will streamline the registration process for OHV users making the process much easier.

This project is based close to Reno, NV and is believed to attract 300+ motorcycles on a weekend to race. Local hotels, grocery stores, fuel stations and OHV dealers in the area will see

increased business due to the race. Increased business leads to support of events that bring that business.

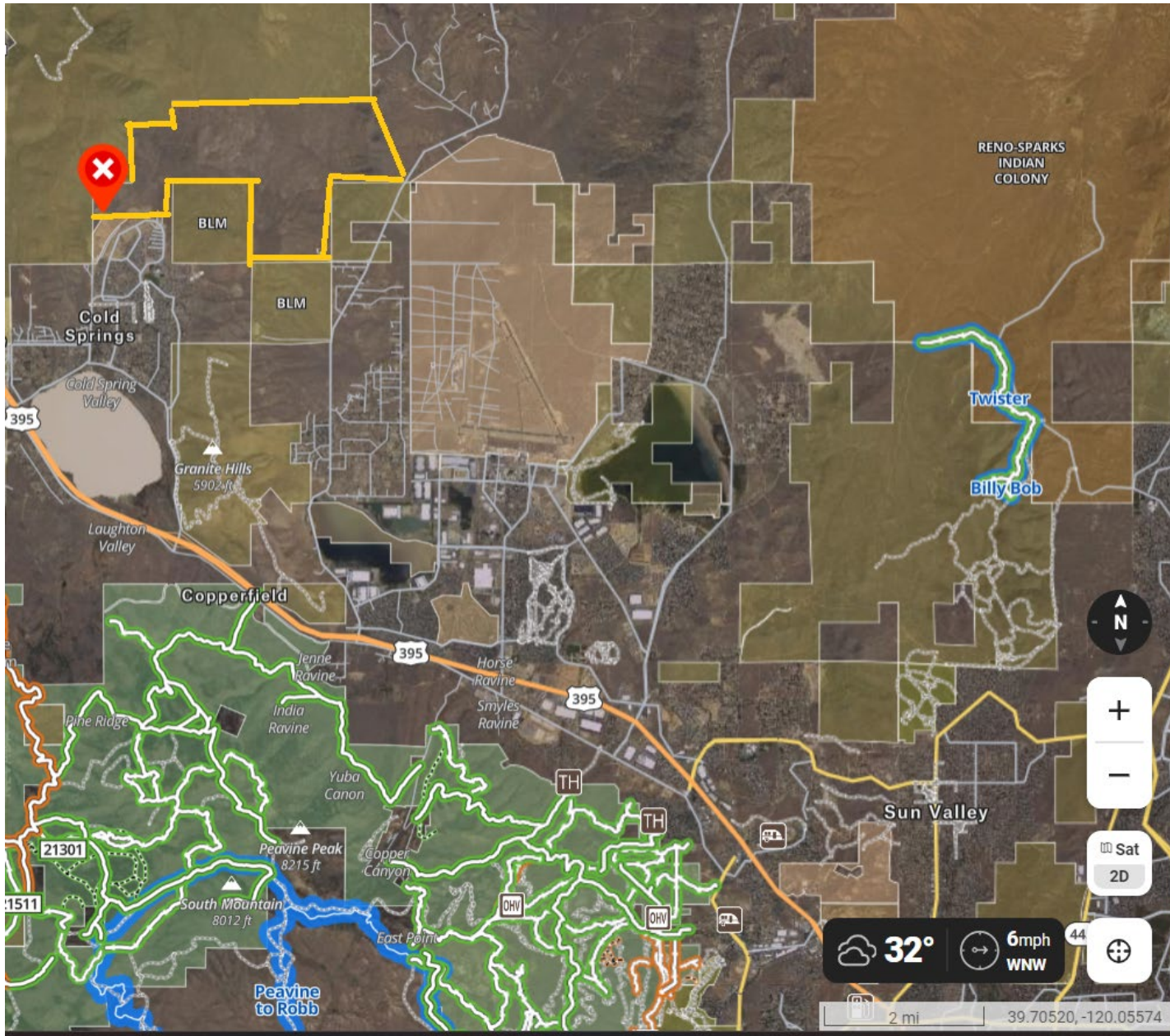

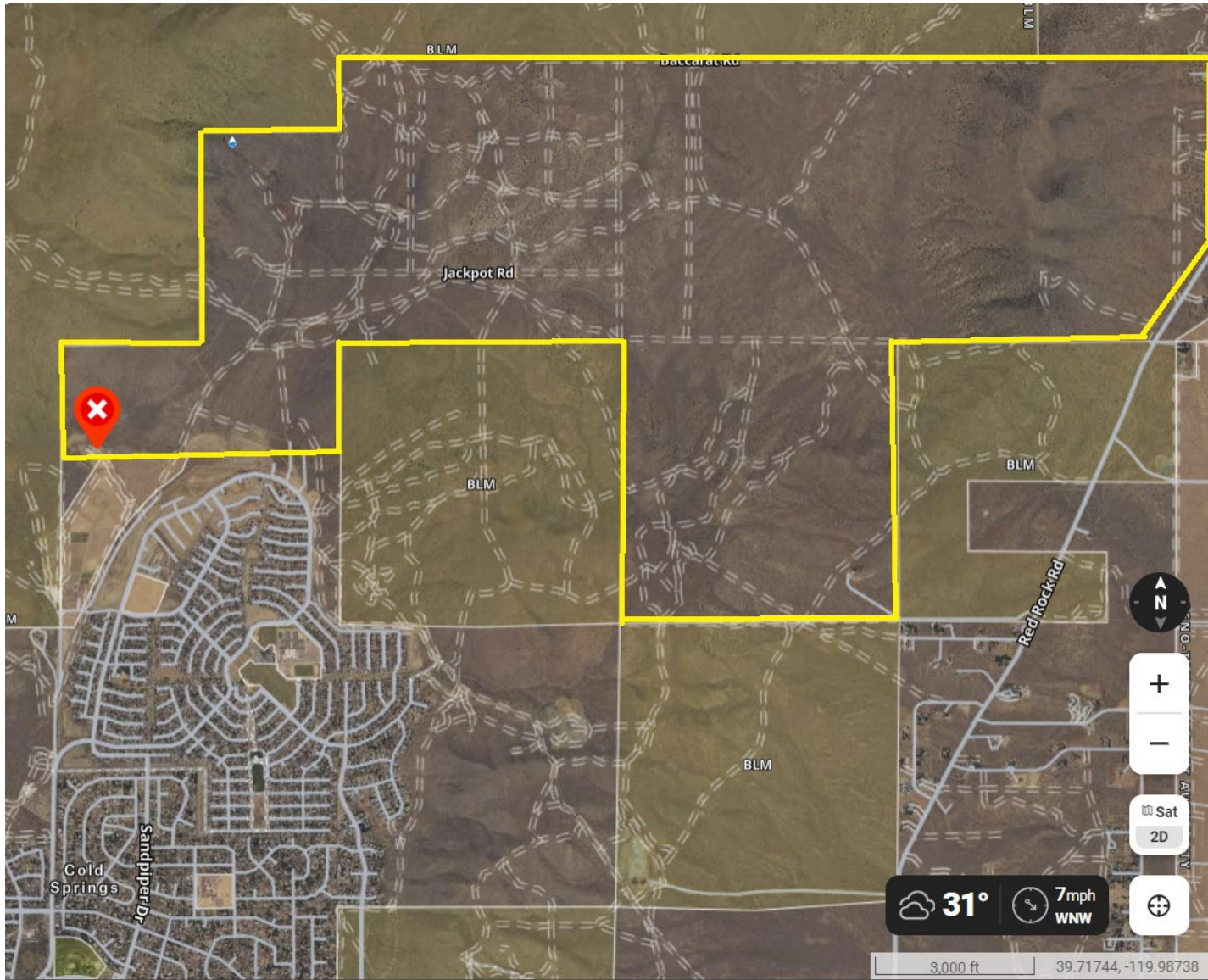

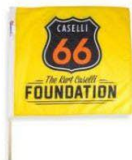
